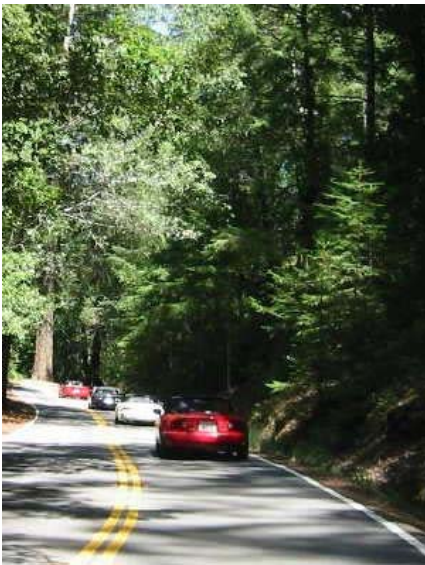

Join Graeme on a fun driver's adventure from Redwood City up over the coastal hills to the coast over roads you may not find on many maps, including a cruise through the Big Basin area! This will be a run with many curves to limber up your suspension but we will be enjoying the scenery and sharing the road with bicyclists so our pace will not be high.



We're planning a few stops to relax, enjoy the ocean and Bay views, talk about our drive, our cars, and whatever else comes to mind in this beautiful coastal hill area. A quick run down Highway 1, with a break for lunch at a Davenport café, will find us turning inland again along picturesque, almost Ireland-like, narrow curvy roads past ranches and farms. Bring your cameras!

We'll offer maps, odometer-based driving instructions and cell-phone numbers, and will have meeting spots to collect ourselves together again should we get split up.

Plan on an exciting run that celebrates the outdoors by getting into it on small (but all paved!) fun roads.

We'll be using FRS Channel 3, Subchannel 0 for communications.

We're on, RAIN or SHINE. Remember, the weather often clears, even after gray morning starts.

#### How To Get To Chevy's in Redwood City

From the North Bay:

- Take 101 South to Redwood City Area
- Take Woodside Road exit West about  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile to El Camino Real
- Left on El Camino Real (south) about  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile to Chevy's, which will be on your left.

From the South Bay:

- Take 101 North to Redwood City Area
- Take Woodside Road exit West about  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile to El Camino Real
- Left on El Camino Real (south) about  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile to Chevy's, which will be on your left.

From the East Bay:

- Either drive west across the Bay Bridge and then south on 101 and follow directions, above, "From North Bay"

OR

- Drive west on the San Mateo Bridge (Hwy 92 from Hayward Area)
- Turn south on 101 and drive about 7 miles to Woodside Road exit
- Take Woodside Road exit west about  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile to El Camino Real
- Left (south) on El Camino Real about  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile to Chevy's, which will be on your left.

Getting home from end point (Foster City, Hwys 101 and 92)

- Either go east on 92 (Hayward- San Mateo Bridge) to East Bay destinations

OR

- Go north or south on Hwy 101 for northern/southern destinations
